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Company History

Victor Lighting, was initially formed as Charles Crofton and Company (Engineers) Limited in July 1929 to sell mining equipment under the trade name Victor. In 1936 the company moved to Wallsend and commenced manufacture of hand held electrical drills for the coal mining industry.

The product range was expanded solely in the coal mining equipment field up to 1939 when the company became involved in the production of aircraft components. In the late 1940's following the nationalisation of the coal mining industry in the UK, Victor began to diversify. Firstly, Victor began to increase export sales of mining equipment. Secondly the company began to develop new products for other industries. The most notable success of this diversification was the introduction of a range of lighting equipment, predominantly for use in the oil, gas and petrochemical industry.

The company name was changed to Victor Products (Wallsend) Limited in July 1944 and became a public company in April 1955. In March 1972 a quotation was obtained for its shares on the stock exchange. Victor Products was then acquired in 1996 by Federal Signal Corporation (FSC) of the USA to complement their existing safety products manufacturing division.

In July 2005, the Hubbell Corporation concluded an agreement with Federal Signal whereby Hubbell Ltd acquired the product lines of Victor Industrial Lighting to form Victor Lighting.

Victor Lighting is now part of the Hubbell Harsh & Hazardous group with manufacturing and operations based in Glasgow, Scotland.

Victor Lighting is committed to quality and is accredited for quality assurance to ISO 9001:2008. The company's products also have approvals and certification from a number of internationally recognised bodies including EECS (Baseefa), BSI, ATEX (Sira) and GOST (Russia) for explosion protection and IP ratings.
